NOTICE OF RACE

1 **RULES**

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing, the Rules of the Flying Fifteen Class Association, and the Loch Ard Sailing Club FF Regatta Sailing Instructions.

3 **ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY**

The regatta is open to boats of the Flying Fifteen class whose helms are current members of BIFFA. Boats must hold a current valid measurement certificate (Open, Silver and Classic). Eligible boats may enter by completing the entry form (found on www.lochardsc.org.uk) and posting it, together with the required fee, to:

Late entries will be accepted on the day prior to the event briefing.

5 **FEES**

Required fees are as follows: £ 50.00 late entry fee after 1st May: £ 5:00

NB: regatta fee includes Saturday evening meal for helm and crew

7 **SCHEDULE**

Registration and late entry: up to briefing time at 12:00 on Saturday 8th May 2010

Number of races: 4 races are scheduled (2 each day) for the event.

Classic and Silver fleet starts may be used, dependant on entries, notified at briefing.

The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race on Saturday is 13:00 and at 11:00 on Sunday.

8 **MEASUREMENTS**

A boat and helm certificate/documents may be requested to be shown at registration.

9 **SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

The sailing instructions are available from www.lochardsc.org.uk or on the day at the club.

20 **DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

21 **INSURANCE**

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of £2,000,000 per event or the equivalent.

For local accommodation suggestions please visit our web site. There will be camping available at our local village hall (10 minutes walk from club) where a meal has been organised for the Saturday evening, additional meal tickets may be purchased for £10 each.
